# Dance Instructions for the 2015 Victory Ball 

Bang $U_{p}$<br>(duple minor)<br>24 measures in 6/8

8 ls pass R, turn single R, pass back R, turn single R
8 ls down middle and back, cast to $2^{\text {nd }}$ place ( 2 s dance up)
$8 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s}$ and 2 s four changes of a circular hey

Bruce Castle Cotillon
(cotillion)
48 measures in 4/4

First change:
16 Whole set dance full circle right, and back left

## Figures:

4 Head couples join hands and pousette backwards and forwards, man pushing to start
4 Head couples promenade across set (clockwise, ladies passing $R$ ) to exchange places
4 Head couples join hands and pousette backwards and forwards, man pushing to start
4 Head couples promenade across set (clockwise, ladies passing R) to exchange places
4 Side couples join hands and pousette backwards and forwards, man pushing to start
4 Side couples promenade across set (clockwise, ladies passing R) to exchange places
4 Side couples join hands and pousette backwards and forwards, man pushing to start

4 Side couples promenade across set (clockwise, ladies passing R) to exchange places

Second change:
16 Ladies circle (Ladies join hands inside set as they circle R , then back L)

Figures (same as above in 32 measures)

Third change:

16 Men's circle (Men join hands inside set as they circle L, then back R)

Figures (same as above in 32 measures)
$8 \quad 1^{\text {st }}$ man set advancing to $2^{\text {nd }}$ lady, retire four steps, 2 H turn
$8 \quad 1^{\text {st }}$ lady set advancing to $2^{\text {nd }}$ man, retire four steps, 2 H turn
8 ls down middle and back - cast (2s lead up)
4 All clap 4 times (to music), partners 2 H turn $1 / 2$ way
8 Circle L, circle R
4 All clap 4 times (to music), partners 2 H turn $1 / 2$ way

8 Partners set twice, RH across $1 / 2$ way
8 Partners set twice, LH across $1 / 2$ way
8 ls cross $\&$ cast, 2 H turn proper
$8 \quad \mathrm{ls}$ and 2 s four changes R \& L
$8 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s}$ and 2 s RH across, LH across back
8 ls chasse twice down middle, chasse twice back up, long cast to $2^{\text {nd }}$ place ( 2 s dance up)
8 Partners RH balance, turn lady under, partners LH balance, turn lady under

8 RH turn R diagonal, LH turn partner

Madm. Buonaparte's Waltz
(duple minor) $\quad 48$ measures in $3 / 8$

8 1s and 2s RH across
$8 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s}$ and 2 s LH across
2 ls cast, 2 s up
$6 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s}$ and 2 s Circle L
8 ls RH turn
16 Pousette counter-clockwise (this can be done traditionally, or with drawing for two measures, 2 H turn on the side of the set for four measures and drawing another two measures to get halfway, then continue with the same timing the rest of the way round)
$8 \quad$ ls set to $2^{\text {nd }}$ woman, circle three hands round
$8 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s}$ set to $2^{\text {nd }}$ man, circle three hands round
8 1s down middle and back - cast (2s dance up)
$8 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s}$ and 2 s four changes R \& L

8 All 3 couples RH turn partner, LH turn partner
8 ls down and back - dance through 2nd place, 1st man casting down between men to form line of three facing up with 3rd couple, 1st
lady
with 2nd
2 Lines set, facing up and down
4 lst couple pass right as they each go out set on own side (1st man between men, lst lady between ladies) and cast down into 3rd
place, $3 s$ leading up
2 Lines set, facing partner
8 Hands 6 round and back

8 ls cast down and go along outside of set, return home
8 ls down middle and back - cast (2s lead up)
8 Circle L, circle R
$8 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s}$ and 2 s four changes circular hey
$8 \quad \mathrm{ls}$ and 2 s set $\mathrm{R} \in \mathrm{L}$ twice; two changes $\mathrm{R} \& \mathrm{~L}$ (end facing neighbor)
8 All set R \& L twice facing person above or below; two changes $\mathrm{R} \mathcal{E}$ L beginning with neighbor
$8 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s}$ down middle and back - cast to $2^{\text {nd }}$ place ( 2 s lead up)
8 All balance R and cross over as man turns lady under; all balance L and cross over as man turns lady under
4 ls RH turn first corner (for $1^{\text {st }}$ man this is $3^{\text {rd }}$ lady, for $1^{\text {st }}$ lady, $2^{\text {nd }}$ man)

4 ls LH turn partner in center of set
4 ls RH turn second corner (for $1^{\text {st }}$ man, $2^{\text {nd }}$ lady, for $1^{\text {st }}$ lady, $3^{\text {rd }}$ man)
4 1s LH turn partner while traveling down set into $3^{\text {rd }}$ place while 3 s cast up to $2^{\text {nd }}$ place

Sir Roger de Coverley
(longways sets for 4,5 , or 6 couples) slipiig in $9 / 8$

While many versions of good Sir Roger exist, this version can be thought of in three simple sections of figures. The first portion of the dance is a series of figures done between the first man and last lady within each set, followed by the first lady and last man of each set. These are referred to as first "diagonal ends," and second "diagonal ends" respectively.
$1^{\text {st }}$ diagonal ends advance and retire; $2^{\text {nd }}$ diagonal ends advance and retire
$1^{\text {st }}$ diagonal ends RH turn; $2^{\text {nd }}$ diagonal ends RH turn
$1^{\text {st }}$ diagonal ends LH turn; $2^{\text {nd }}$ diagonal ends LH turn
$1^{\text {st }}$ diagonal ends 2 H turn; $2^{\text {nd }}$ diagonal ends 2 H turn
$1^{\text {st }}$ diagonal ends back-to-back; $2^{\text {nd }}$ diagonal ends back-to-back
$1^{\text {st }}$ couple lace down the set (This means $1^{\text {st }}$ couple arm R with each $11 / 2$ times to begin, which faces them towards the line of the opposite gender. $1^{\text {st }}$ couple then alternates arm L with each successive person down the line of opposite gender and arm $R$ with partner, until they reach the bottom of the set, ending with arm $R$ with partner to come to their own side of the set.)
$1^{\text {st }}$ couple promenade to the top of the set, then cast off on their own side followed by the line of dancers on their side of the set. $1^{\text {st }}$ couple stops at the bottom of the set and forms an arch, through which all other couples pass on their way up to progressed position (each couple will have moved up one place, with $1^{\text {st }}$ couple now at the bottom of the set)

8 Partners set twice, RH across
8 Partners set twice, LH across
8 1s down and back - dance into $2^{\text {nd }}$ place, 2 s leading up
8 RH turn partner, LH partner

Tars of the Victory
(triple minor) 32 measures in $6 / 8$

8 1st lady casts, followed by 1st man chasing, all the way around 3rd couple back home
8 lst man casts, followed by 1st lady chasing, all the way around 3rd couple back home
8 1st couple leads 2nd and 3rd couple in full promenade back home
$8 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s}$ and 2 s pousette $11 / 2$ times
$8 \quad \mathrm{ls}$ cross $\&$ cast, 2 H turn proper
$8 \quad 1 \mathrm{~s}$ and 2 s RH across, LH across back

The Way to be Happy (duple minor) $\quad 32$ measures in $6 / 8$

8 RH across, LH across back
8 Circle L, circle R
8 ls down middle and back - cast (2s lead up)
8 ls and 2 s four changes $\mathrm{R} \& \mathrm{~L}$
